Travel

By air : Copenhagen has one airport, Copenhagen Airport. The easiest way to get to and from the airport is by Metro. Trains from the airport to Copenhagen Central Station depart every ten minutes, and the journey is about 20 minutes. Tickets can be purchased at any metro station or train station. A ride with either train, bus or Metro equals three zones and costs DKK 38. More information on getting to and from the airport can be found <u>here</u>.

By train : International trains arrive at Copenhagen Central Station, which is located in the city center with access to trains, busses and taxis (no metro) (a 2 zone ticket can get you to any of the suggested hotels as well as to the Copenhagen Business School).

Getting around : you can plan any itinerary for getting around Copenhagen here.

Biking is a very easy way to get around in Copenhagen. You could make use of the public bikeshare, Bycyklen. Bycyklen bikes are intelligent electric bikes, that are available all over the city and are easy to use. More information on the City Bike system can be found <u>here</u> and <u>here</u>.

Accomodation

We suggest staying in central Copenhagen, as the Copenhagen Business School is located in the city, and can be accessed very easily by metro or bus. Travelling from any of the suggested hotels to Copenhagen Business School requires a standard 2 zone ticket for bus or metro. Discounts are available but codes may not be published online. Hotel Astoria (3*)	Banegaardspl adsen 4, 1570 Copenhagen V.	788DKK (106€)	16 minutes (bus & metro)	Book this hotel*	7,2: Situated next to Copenhagen Central Station, this hotel is centrally located in the city's vibrant Vesterbro district. Tivoli Gardens is just a 3-minute walk away.
