Long room and Book of Kells

Trinity College Dublin is home to the Long Room, a magnificent 18th century library, and the Book of Kells, an eighth century illuminated manuscript of the four gospels. We are delighted to offer conference participants complimentary tickets to visit the Long Room and Book of Kells during their stay in Dublin. As tickets are available on a timed entry basis, with numbers restricted under Covid conditions, you will need to indicate the date and the time that you would like to visit. Tickets are only good for the date and time issued.

Your email should indicate:

1. Date ticket/s is/are required. Dates available are Wednesday 1st December through Sunday 5th December.
2. The time you would like to visit. Entry is on the hour and half hour, and the exhibit is open as follows: Monday-Saturday 9:30-17:00 (last ticket slot 16:00pm) and Sunday 12:00-16:30 (last ticket slot 15:30).
3. Number of tickets you require. Each conference member can request one or two tickets.
4. Example format for request email: "I would like 2 tickets for Wednesday 1st December at 11:30am"

You will receive a confirmation of email receipt within 48 hours of sending your email.
